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# Code4Health Community Profiles

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## Objective

To create a library of community created, clinically assured FHIR profiles to support interoperability flows within the NHS in England.

- FHIR profiles to be created, reviewed and published in the public
- Additions to the library should be driven by the Code4Health community
- The FHIR profiles to be “open source” and be unhindered by any restrictive licensing

# Code4Health Community Profiles

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## Creating Community Profiles

- Profiles already exist with the English FHIR landscape (Endeavour, HSCIC etc. )
- Profiles already exist in the international space ( DAF, Argonaut etc.)
- Community profiles should be look to harmonize with existing work so as to minimise impact on implementers

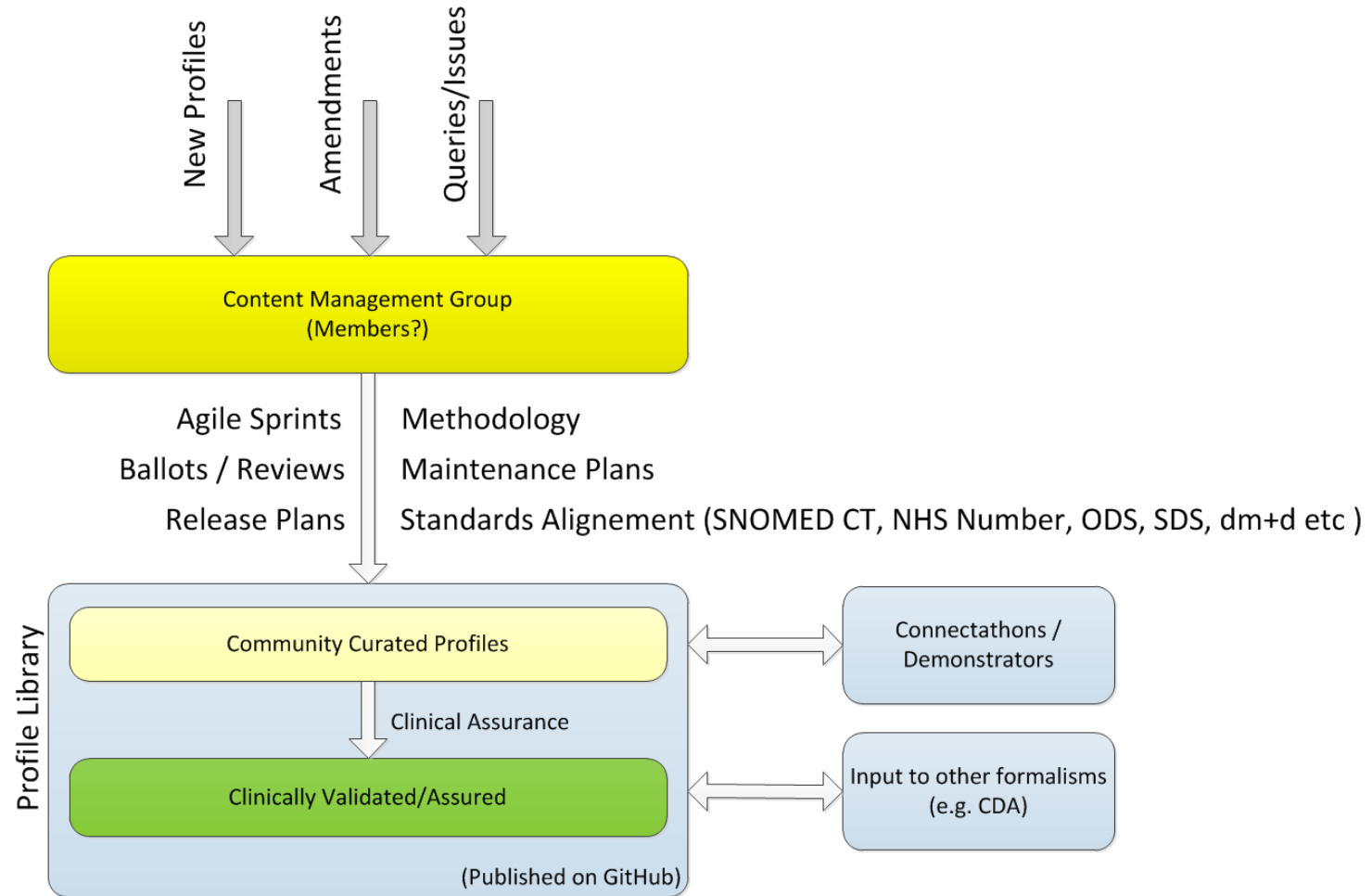
